

# Author Copyright Agreement

In order to publish your article in the Acta Stomatologica Croatica - ASCRO ("ASCRO") we need your agreement. Please take a moment to read the terms of this license.

By submitting your article to ASCRO, you and all co-authors of your submission agree to the terms of this license. You do not need to fill out a copyright form for confirmation.

By submitting your article to ASCRO you grant us (the publisher) the exclusive right to both reproduce and/or distribute your article (including the abstract) throughout the world in electronic, printed or any other form, and to authorize others (including Reproduction Rights Organizations such as the Copyright Licensing Agency and the Copyright Clearance Center, and other document distributors) to do the same. You agree that we may publish your article, and that we may sell or distribute it, on its own, or with other related material.

By submitting your article for publication to ASCRO, you represent and warrant that the article: (a) is your original work, has not previously been published, and is not currently under consideration by another journal; (b) does not contain anything that is libelous, defamatory or previously published, in whole or in part; (c) does not infringe anyone's copyright or other rights. If the article contains material that is someone else's copyright, you warrant that you have previously obtained the unrestricted permission of the copyright owner to use the material and that this material is clearly identified and acknowledged in the text.

We declare that we will respect your rights as the author(s). That is, we will make sure that your name(s) is/are always clearly associated with the article and, while you do allow us to make necessary editorial changes, we will not make any substantial alterations to your article without consulting you.

You are free to use your article for internal, educational or other purposes of your own institution or company. You may post a preprint version of your ASCRO article on your Web site while your article is in press. You must prominently state near the title of the preprint version that the article has been accepted for publication by ASCRO in a revised form. Once an article has been published by ASCRO, you may post the ASCRO version of your article (the ASCRO PDF) on your Web site. You need not request permission from ASCRO to post the PDF, but together with its link you must provide the standard bibliographic citation, acknowledge ASCRO as the copyright owner, and incorporate a link to the ASCRO Web site.
